

Junk-cessorise.

This tutorial shows you how to create a necklace and a pair of earrings out of your own junk. **by: Noor Issa**

1



Go to any hardware store and find the following:
• Metal wires • Different sizes of washers (flat metal rings)
• 2 flat metal rectangles with 2 holes punched in it
• A lot of nuts (the metal kind!) • A wire cutter.

Measure the metal wire around your neck to find the measurement of your necklace. Cut 10 pieces of the wire approximately the same size.

Take the flat metal rectangles with the 2 holes and stick 5 of the wires inside one hole and another 5 in the other.

Start adding different sizes of nuts at random. If you want them to be stuck on one side take one nut and put it through 2 wires to stop the movement. Add some of the smallest washers in between the nuts to give some variation in shape.

5



Take the largest washer and put through 3 to 4 wires so that it moves but is stable.

6



Continue adding nuts until it's as full as you want it to be. >

7



Cut the edges of the wires so they are all the same length. Stick 5 wires at random in each hole of the second rectangle. Twist and tighten the ends so nothing falls off.

To close the necklace, I used a big safety pin. Or else you can create your own clasp.

In less than an hour you have the coolest necklace to wear when you go clubbing, and you know no one else will have it.

If you have any washers left you can make a pair of earrings to go with the necklace:



Cut a small piece of wire.

2



Twist it around one side of the washer. Tighten it with the wire cutter.

3



Get hooks for the earrings from old ones or you can find them in stores. Hook them onto the metal wire.

Note: There are different weights of washers. Make sure you get the lighter ones for your ears.
All this will cost you only JD3.99... Wear responsibly. •
